



# Troop 24

## Rules



1. Dues \$1.00 per week, or \$52.00 per year
2. Meetings are only canceled during the winter months if Vigo county schools are closed due to snow.
3. Scouts shall not attend any “fun activity” or “campout” if he is not present 2 meetings prior to the activity, unless excused by the scoutmaster.
4. The soft drink machine is off limits during meeting. (This applies to adults and scouts) soft drinks may be purchased before and/or after the meeting. Soft drinks shall not be drunk during meeting.
5. **Keep hands & feet to yourself no horseplay or fighting.**
6. Ask scoutmaster or assistant scoutmaster for permission to go upstairs for any reason, including getting a drink. All other rooms are off limits except with permission
7. No sitting on tables, and keep all four chair legs on the floor.
8. The piano is off limits.
9. The floor shall be cleaned after the meeting.
10. Keep doors upstairs closed.
11. One warning will be given to a problem scout. If undisciplined acts continue, then the scout shall be sent home
12. Be in full class “a” uniform at all meeting (unless told otherwise) **first time without is a write-up, second time results in expulsion from next eligible campout.**
13. Anyone caught with an illegal drug will be kicked out of troop

14. Anyone caught defacing or damaging the property of someone else, will be expelled from the troop for 1 month and a note of apology to the property owner and the troop will be given in front of everyone and repair or replacement of the defaced or damaged property
15. Anyone caught cursing, using vulgar or obscene language will be told to leave the meeting and will have to pay an extra \$1.00 dues per occurrence at the next meeting and will not be allowed to attend meetings until it is paid
16. Anyone leaving camp without the permission of the scoutmaster or acting scoutmaster will be filed (turned in) as a runaway to the police, and will be kicked out of the troop
17. No toys, radios, CD players, TV's or video games are allowed on campouts or in meetings. The only exemption is if the scoutmaster approves of taking it on the car ride only
18. Soda, pop, & candy can only be brought on special accessions and with approval of the scoutmaster
19. No food in tents
20. Abide by the leaders SPL and PL at all times
21. No name calling
22. Check in all medications when going on any activity
23. Do not use knives, axe, hatchet or saws without totem chip or special permission
24. Dues must be paid up-to-date to attend campout or any fun activities
25. Food money must be paid before campout, at the beginning of campout or the week after
26. During a campout/meeting if you do not do what a leader says you will be penalized one campout or more
27. No gang signs or symbols
28. Anyone Caught Leaving the Camp Site With Out Permission From SPL, ASPL, Scoutmaster, or Assistant Scoutmaster will be penalized one campout or more.
